TSMA brings together hundreds of professionals and more than 116 businesses to create a stronger, more competitive manufacturing environment in the Evansville Region. Through collaboration, education, and strategic initiatives, TSMA is shaping the future of regional manufacturing.



Supported **six active TSMA Peer Groups** (Lean, HR, Safety, Future Leaders, CFO, and Manufacturing Reliability & Data Analytics), convening **33 peer group** meetings, plant tours, and roundtables to drive collaboration and knowledge-sharing.



Hosted the 2025 Evansville Region Manufacturing Summit, welcoming **230 attendees** to the region's largest annual manufacturing event, featuring four keynote speakers, ten breakout sessions, a vendor fair, and Power Hour networking.



Engaged **125+ manufacturing professionals** through workshops and delivered eight hands-on trainings on leadership, process improvement, workforce strategies, cellular flow, AI in manufacturing, and finance fundamentals.



Conducted **42 BR&E manufacturer site visits**, partnering with E-REP to connect companies with workforce programs, training resources, and state-level support.
